

Annual Report - 2022

- 1. Youth Day Celebration: On 12th January 2022, we celebrated National Youth Day and hosted a session on "Empowering Youth for Sustainable Careers." A prominent youth leader was invited to speak about skill development and entrepreneurship opportunities in agriculture and technology. The event was held in Kalaburagi with active youth participation.
- Republic Day Celebration: On 26th January 2022, Republic Day was
 celebrated with a flag hoisting ceremony by senior local leaders. They were
 honored with shawls and mementos, and discussions on "Building a Responsible
 Nation" were conducted.
- 3. World Cancer Day: On 4th February 2022, a cancer awareness camp was organized in a slum area of Kalaburagi. Two local doctors provided educational sessions on early cancer detection and prevention strategies. About 120 people attended, and doctors were honored with shawls and mementos.
- 4. Women's Day Celebration: On 8th March 2022, International Women's Day was celebrated at the RAMA Foundation office. Female staff and volunteers were honored by the president, who spoke on the importance of women's contributions to society and humanitarian work.

- 5. Digital Literacy Workshop: In April 2022, a digital literacy workshop was conducted in Afzalpur, aiming to improve computer skills and internet awareness among youth and women. The program covered basic computer operations and safe internet usage.
- 6. **International Labour Day:** On 1st May 2022, International Labour Day was celebrated in Chincholi. Masks and food packages were distributed to daily wage laborers, along with a session on workers' rights and safety.
- 7. Food Distribution: From 5th to 15th May 2022, food and essential supplies were distributed to economically disadvantaged families and undernourished children in Sedam. This initiative, focusing on nutritional support and well-being, reached over 200 families.
- 8. **Environment Day:** On 5th June 2022, World Environment Day was observed with a tree plantation drive. Local residents and senior citizens participated in planting trees and discussing sustainable living practices.
- National Doctor's Day: On 1st July 2022, doctors in Kalaburagi were honored for their relentless service to the community. They were presented with shawls and saplings to express gratitude.
- 10. Independence Day Celebration: Independence Day was marked on 15th August 2022 with a flag-hoisting ceremony at the RAMA Foundation premises. Members participated in cultural performances and reflections on India's progress.

- 11. **Teacher's Day Celebration:** On 5th September 2022, government school teachers were invited and honored for their dedication. Interactive games and discussions on education reforms were organized.
- 12. Awareness Program on Organic Farming: On 18th September 2022, a program at Kalyana Karnataka Nadoji Dr. Narayan Reddy Krishi Kendra promoted organic farming. Several farmers shared success stories and best practices.
- 13. **Gandhi Jayanti:** On 2nd October 2022, a cleanliness drive was conducted, focusing on reducing single-use plastics. Women from the locality participated, learning practical ways to maintain a plastic-free environment.
