

Annual Report - 2023

- Youth Day Celebration (January 12): On 12th January 2023, National Youth Day was celebrated with a seminar on "Youth in Leadership and Sustainable Development" in Yadgir. Youth leaders discussed innovations in technology and rural entrepreneurship, inspiring local students with success stories and career mentorship.
- 2. **Republic Day Celebration (January 26):** On 26th January 2023, Republic Day was commemorated in Kalaburagi with a flag-hoisting ceremony and a street play promoting civic responsibility, democratic values, and women's empowerment.
- 3. World Cancer Day (February 4): On 4th February 2023, a cancer awareness campaign in Yadgir involved health experts providing free screenings and talks on early detection and lifestyle changes. Over 150 residents attended, and follow-up medical consultations were arranged.
- 4. International Women's Day (March 8): On 8th March 2023, International Women's Day was observed in Kalaburagi. The event highlighted women's achievements in community leadership and business. Entrepreneurs shared success stories, and a workshop on financial independence was conducted.
