

Annual Report - 2024

- Youth Day Celebration (January 12): On 12th January 2024, National Youth Day was celebrated in Kalaburagi with a theme on "Youth in Digital Transformation." The event included workshops on artificial intelligence and leadership for the digital economy. Interactive sessions on creative problem-solving and social entrepreneurship were also held.
- 2. **Republic Day Celebration (January 26):** On 26th January 2024, Republic Day was observed in Yadgir with a grand flag-hoisting event and a debate competition on the role of constitutional values in contemporary India.
- 3. World Cancer Awareness Drive (February 4): On 4th February 2024, a month-long cancer awareness drive was launched in Kalaburagi. Free screenings and educational sessions on cancer prevention were offered in multiple villages. Community health volunteers were trained to spread awareness about lifestyle modifications.
- 4. Women's Empowerment Forum (March 8): On 8th March 2024, International Women's Day was celebrated in Yadgir with a forum addressing women's rights and digital literacy. Successful women entrepreneurs were invited to mentor participants. A workshop on self-defense techniques for women was also organized.

- 5. Skill Development Workshop (March 25): A skill development workshop on 25th March 2024 in Sedam introduced vocational training in solar panel installation and repair, aimed at promoting green jobs. Additional modules on financial management for small businesses were provided.
- 6. Water Conservation Awareness Program (April 5): On 5th April 2024, a campaign in Kalaburagi focused on water conservation techniques for farmers. Experts demonstrated rainwater harvesting and micro-irrigation systems. Farmers received kits for building low-cost water storage solutions.
- 7. Food Security and Nutrition Initiative (May 5-10): From 5th to 10th May 2024, food and nutrition packs were distributed in Shahapur, prioritizing children and pregnant women. Health check-ups and dietary counseling were also conducted. Cooking demonstrations promoting balanced diets using local produce were included.
- 8. Labour Rights Awareness Camp (May 1): On 1st May 2024, Labour Day was celebrated in Yadgir with an awareness camp on workers' rights, workplace safety, and new labor laws. A medical camp for laborers and a financial literacy session on saving schemes were also held.
- 9. Environment Day (June 5): On 5th June 2024, a large-scale tree plantation drive was organized in Kalaburagi. Public awareness sessions on climate change adaptation and plastic pollution reduction were held. Competitions for students on eco-friendly innovations were also part of the event.
- 10. National Doctor's Day (July 1): On 1st July 2024, doctors in Yadgir were honored for their community service. Workshops on leveraging telemedicine for rural healthcare were

part of the event. A seminar on mental health challenges in underserved areas was also conducted.

- 11. **Independence Day Celebration (August 15):** On 15th August 2024, Independence Day was marked in Kalaburagi with a cultural showcase and a seminar on "Nation Building through Sustainable Development Goals." The event featured a parade of local school children and performances celebrating India's cultural diversity.
- 12. **Teacher's Day Celebration (September 5):** On 5th September 2024, teachers in Shahapur were recognized for excellence in innovative teaching. A roundtable on integrating experiential learning in rural schools was conducted. A creative teaching tools exhibition was also organized.
- 13. Farmers' Innovation Meet (September 25): On 25th September 2024, a farmers' meet in Yadgir highlighted sustainable pest management and market access strategies. Experts shared insights on eco-friendly fertilizers. A marketplace for organic produce was set up to link farmers with local buyers.
- 14. Gandhi Jayanti (October 2): On 2nd October 2024, a cleanliness drive was organized in Kalaburagi focusing on e-waste recycling. Workshops on the environmental impact of electronic waste were included. Awareness leaflets on reducing electronic consumption were distributed.
- 15. Mental Health and Well-being Initiative (October 15): A mental health program in Yadgir on 15th October 2024 provided free counseling and sessions on managing anxiety and stress in the digital age. Specialized sessions on handling exam-related stress for students were conducted.

- 16. Children's Day (November 14): On 14th November 2024, Children's Day was celebrated in Kalaburagi with robotics workshops and science experiments for underprivileged children. Storytelling sessions and creative arts competitions were also part of the celebrations.
- 17. World AIDS Day (December 1): On 1st December 2024, an awareness camp on HIV/AIDS was held in Shahapur. Free medical tests and counseling were provided. A special session on reducing stigma and misconceptions about HIV was held.
- 18. Kisan Divas (December 23): On 23rd December 2024, Farmers Day was celebrated in Sedam with sessions on precision agriculture and subsidies for renewable energy usage. A demonstration of drone technology in farming was showcased.
